



ASIAL Member Recognition Program

Terms and conditions

1. Only full financial Corporate Members of the Association are eligible.
2. Cumulative years of membership up until 31/12/10 will be calculated to establish the initial Member recognition level.
3. To obtain and maintain a recognition level, a Member must hold continuous ASIAL membership.
4. Should a Member resign from the Association with a recognition level of Silver or higher, the Member may rejoin within two years at one recognition level lower than their exiting level.
5. Should a Member be expelled from the Association they will be required to start the recognition program from the standard member level.
6. Should a Member breach the ASIAL Code of Conduct, the ASIAL Board reserves the right to review the Member's recognition status.
7. Members are required to provide current copies of Firm/Master Licences, Public Liability insurance cover, details of their Duly Appointed Representative and Confirmation of Category form.
8. Recognition levels are subject to change without prior written warning.
9. Membership from other Associations will not count towards a recognition level.
10. Where there is uncertainty as to whether a Member is eligible for recognition status, the Member will be requested to provide evidence of Member lineage. Should the secretariat be unable to validate Member lineage, the matter may be referred to the ASIAL Board for consideration.
