- **Proposed session title**
- **Your details** (including Name, Title, Organisation, Street Address, Postal Address (if different), Country, phone, fax and mobile numbers, E-mail address.
- **Biography** – please include your biographical details with the submission.
- **Session objective** – please outline what you aim to achieve in your session.
- **Audio Visual support** – please indicate what audiovisual support or other materials your presentation requires.
- **Speaking experience** – please list conferences to which you have made presentations over the past two years.
